Rules & Regulations:

1. No limit on age of exhibitor.
2. All exhibitors must sign the disclaimer. If exhibitor is under 18 years of age, a parent/guardian must sign the disclaimer.
3. Limited to the first 50 entries – limit of 2 animals/entries per participant.
4. Each pet must have their own secure cage – with solid bottom.
5. Each pet must remain in cages.
6. Only exhibitor can handle their animals.
7. Exhibitor must provide water and feed for their pet.
8. Animals previously entered in this fair under 4-H and FFA are not allowed.
9. No selling of pets allowed on fairgrounds.
10. No poultry, turtles, snakes or spiders allowed.
11. Pets required by law to have health papers must have them available for veterinarian.
12. Any pets required by law to have health papers must have them available for veterinarian.
13. Pets to arrive one hour prior to show and leave the grounds immediately after show.
Exhibitors may get stamped and return to the fairgrounds without pet on the same day.
14. By participating in this contest, all contestants and their parents will authorize by signature and grant the Walworth County Fair the right to publicize and/or broadcast a contestant's name, character, likeness, event photographs, voices and the fact that he/she has participated in and or won the Unusual House Pet Show competition without receiving additional compensation.

Each exhibitor must pay an entry fee of \$3.00 per entry. Registration deadline is Monday, August 2, 2010, along with pet ownership by that date.

****The Walworth County Fair Board has the right to reject any entry.****

There will be (3) three general categories.

- A. Furrries** – mice, rats, gerbils, hamsters, ferrets, weasels, rabbits, cavies, hedgehogs
- B. Feathers & Fins** – all fish, Caged Birds including parakeets, canaries, cockatiels, finches, parrots
- C. Creepers & Crawlers** – lizards, iguanas, salamanders
(Must present Health Certificates for creepers & crawlers per veterinarian)
