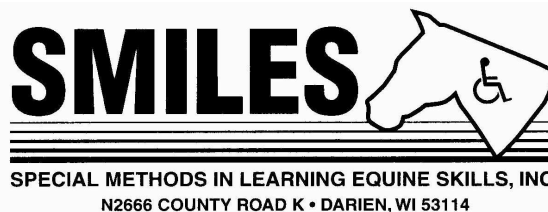

## NO CROSS ENTERING OF AGE BRACKETS

Separate entry number required for each horse/rider combination. **As of 1/1/10: Tiny Tot: 10 & under, Jr. Jr.: 11-13, Jr.: 14-17, Sr.: 18 & over,** Classes will have no more than 20 horses working at one time. Tiny Tots will be split at 10 horses. Entries are required by the time the previous class is called. 3-minute gate hold will be enforced. An additional 3 minutes will be allowed for a requested tack change necessity. Tack change requests are required by the time the previous class is called. Once gate is closed, no entry permitted. All entries \$6 plus \$1 office fee per horse/rider combination. All proceeds go to benefit SMILES Therapeutic Riding Program. Show will take place rain or shine. Food on grounds. Fairgrounds require the use of shavings as bedding—available at show. Not responsible for lost or stolen articles or for damages to or by animals on grounds. All stallions must have supervision at all times. Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine classes at their discretion. In case of a tie for High Point, highest place in Showmanship wins. No refunds. Original current Coggins papers must be shown and a copy left for SMILES files.
